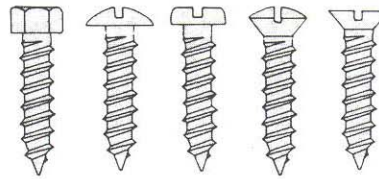


SCREWS

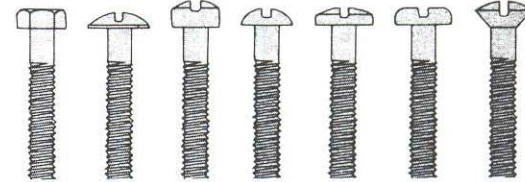
General-purpose screws (used in tapped holes) usually with plain sheared points. Commonly used with square or hex nuts, these screws are frequently referred to as stove bolts. This fastener type is available in a wide variety of head styles and with a number of driving recesses.

WOOD SCREWS

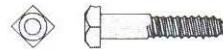
Cut their own mating thread in wood. In hard wood, a pre-drilled starter hole is required to prevent splitting of the material.



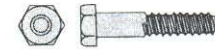
Flat Round Oval

LAG SCREWS

Fastener, with threaded conical point, normally used in wood or masonry with an expansion anchor fitted into a pre-drilled hole.
